This collection of papers and lectures on early Indian history by one of India's foremost historians focuses on historiography and the changing dimensions of social and cultural history. The essays have been grouped thematically in nine sections : historiography; social and cultural transactions; archaeology and history; pre-Mauryan and Mauryan India; forms of exchange; the society of heroes in the epics and the later tradition of venerating heroes; genealogies and origin myths; the social context of the renouncer; and the present in the past, which looks at how current ideologies make use of the early past. The collective publication of these important pieces-written over the last forty years and published in various journals-makes them newly accessible to Professor Thapar's many readers.
